# **2022 Spring English Course**

# (2 units of credit) for Graduates

#### ■ 講義のねらい

英語圏の大学で教育を受けるのに十分であり、また近い将来研究者コミュニティの中で活躍するための英語力を身に付けることを目標として、英語による口頭表現能力向上のための訓練を短期集中で行います。この授業は「英語スピーキング演習 GIV」(大学院課程の学生対象)という英語の選択科目で、2単位を取得できます。

#### Overall Objectives of the Graduate-level Course

The objective of this short-term intensive course is to train graduate students in such a way as to increase their abilities in English oral expression, to the point where they can participate in tertiary education in the English-speaking world, or be active as members of international research communities in the near future. The course is titled "Oral Expression in English GIV", and is for graduate students. This is an English elective subject, and participants are eligible to receive 2 units of credit.

Course Description: This five-day intensive course is designed for students looking for a forum that will allow them to practice and enhance both their English speaking and presentation skills. It will be student-centered and active participation will be expected. Students will be presented with various topics designed to utilize and boost their critical thinking skills through discussion & debate. They will also be required to make daily presentations (individually and in groups). Vocabulary building and active listening will be critical components of the course.
